

“EIGHT: TWENTY-EIGHT IT”

ROMANS 8:28

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

THAT GOD WORKS in all circumstances and in all situations to enable you to trust again and again the faithfulness of Jesus Christ. (**Romans 8:28, Philippians 1:3-6, fn 1:6[1st], fn 1:6[2nd], Philippians 4:4-7, 10-13, fn 4:4, fn 4:4, 5, fn 4:10-14, fn 4:12, 13, I Corinthians 1:4-9, I Thessalonians 5:18, fn 5:18, Hebrews 7:25, 26, fn 7:25[2nd]**) *How have you seen God work in your past for your good?*

FOR YOUR GOOD (YOUR ULTIMATE GOOD). The Holy Spirit is present in you every moment, every second of your day. God promises that all your life events will bring good not only for this life but for the one to come. (**Romans 8:28, I Peter 1:3-7, fn 1:7, Genesis 50:15-21, fn 50:20, Jeremiah 29:11-13, fn 29:12-14, Romans 8:31-39, fn 8:35-39, Hebrews 11:35-40, fn 11:35-39, Habakkuk 3:17-19, fn 3:17-19**) *How could the promises of Romans 8:28 prepare you for your future?*
