

DAVID PROPHESED

ACTS 2:25-36

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

BACKGROUND: Acts 2:25 tells us that Jesus is at the God's right hand. He helps in action and in suffering. In Acts 2:34, 35 the term "right hand" is used for recognizing and giving equal honor and equal dignity. Spiro Zodhiates, Word Studies in the New Testament, page 405.

OF JESUS' RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD. He did not waver or change His mind no matter what the circumstances were. (Acts 2:25, 26, Psalm 16:8-11, fn 16:8, fn 16:8-11, Philippians 4:11-13, fn 4:10-14) *What is necessary for you not to be shaken but to be content in all circumstances?*

OF JESUS' RESURRECTION. David's prophecy and his death and the presence of the Holy Spirit gave proof of Christ's resurrection in the fulfillment of Scripture. Because He ascended to heaven, the Holy Spirit was poured out. (Acts 2:27-33, fn 2:25-32, Psalm 16:10, fn 16:10, I Corinthians 15:12-20, fn 15:13-18) *How does your life give proof of Christ's resurrection?*

OF JESUS, THE MESSIAH (CHRIST CRUCIFIED BY YOU AND ME). The Messiah or Christ is the Anointed One, the Supreme Deliverer from our sin. (Acts 2:34-36, Psalms 110:1,2, fn 110:1-7, Matthew 16:13-19, fn 16:13-17, Romans 4:23-25, Romans 5:6-8, fn 5:6, fn 5:8) *Did your sin cause Christ to go to the cross? Do you confess "I did it."? Why or why not?*
