JOHN 8:1-11

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

FROM THE “TRAP” (a hypocritical, judgmental attitude that tears others down to build oneself up) Jesus was being accused as well as the woman. (**John 8:1-8, fn 8:7, Matthew 7:1-5, fn 7:1, 2, fn 7:1-5, Romans 2:1-4, fn 2:1, fn 2:1ff**) *What would be your attitude when you are accused of sin?*

FROM CONDEMNATION (**John 8:8-11, John 3:17-18, fn 3:18, Romans 8:1, fn 8:1, Romans 8:31-34, Colossians 1:22, fn 1:22, 23, Psalms 103:12, fn 103:12, Hebrews 7:25-28, fn 7:25**) *What is the only way to be forgiven of our sins, and who has the power to forgive sin? Do we have to continue confessing the same sin over and over? (See II Peter 1:8, 9)*

FROM SIN’S POWER AND A LIFE OF SIN (**John 8:11, fn 8:11, Titus 2:11-14, fn 2:11-14, Galatians 5:16, Romans 6:1, 2, fn 6:1, 2, I John 1:9**) *If you sin, how do you restore your intimacy with the Lord?*

Check up—Are you praying with your spouse and your family? Group—Pray for personal requests and bond together by fellowshiping together.
