

GET READY

ROMANS 10:11-13

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

BACKGROUND: Our Lord is sovereign, but He gives you responsibility in leading others to Christ so that the gospel does not stop with you. (II Timothy 4:5)

TO GO WITH CONFIDENCE. It's not you on display. It's the gospel! The promise is that the gospel has power to save, and you will not be disappointed or ashamed in its effectiveness. It's Jesus who saves, but it is you who carries the message. It's not the messenger that saves. It's the message. (Romans 10:11, fn 10:14, Romans 9:33, Romans 5:5, Romans 1:14-16, fn 1:15, fn 1:16[1st], Isaiah 55:11, Hebrew 4:12, 13, fn 4:12) *Write out your testimony of your life before and after coming to Christ. Share with your group and ask for input.*

TO SHARE WITH EVERYONE. There was no discrimination on the cross. Jesus died for everyone—for all people, for all times. Therefore, the gospel must be shared with everyone. (Romans 10:12, Matthew 28:18-20, fn 28:18-20, Acts 10:34-43, fn 10:37-43, Philemon 6, fn 6, Mark 10:29, 30, fn 10:29, 30) *Make a list of ten people with whom you can share the gospel.*

TO SEE AND EXPERIENCE the rich blessing of new birth. There is a joy like no other when you lead someone to Christ. That someone with new life receives abundant spiritual gifts from his Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be a witness to God's saving power! (Romans 10:12, 13, John 4:31-42, fn 4:34, fn 4:35, fn 4:36-38, II Corinthians 5:11-6:2, fn 5:20, fn 6:2) *How will you pray for our Lord to use you in leading someone to Christ?*

Check up—Are you praying with your spouse and your family? Group—Pray for personal requests and bond together by fellowshiping together.
