JESUS PRAYS—HIS DISCIPLES JOHN 17:6-19

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

KNOW—IF YOU BELIEVE, YOU KNOW. You cannot know without faith. Because of the disciples' faith (John 6:31), Jesus reveals the Father to them. (John 17:6-10, John 17:25, 26, Hebrews 11:6, John 16:13-15, fn 16:13[2ND], I John 5:20, Luke 24:45, fn 24:45, II Corinthians 3:14-18, fn 3:18) From John 17:6-10 & verse 13, what did God reveal to the disciples and to you?

ARE PROTECTED—KEPT SECURE. "The names of God stand not only for his character but also for His power." F.F. Bruce, <u>John</u>, page 332. Because of God's power, we are protected from Satan and kept eternally secure in Jesus. (John 17:11-15, fn 17:14, John 10:25-30, fn 10:28, 29, Psalms 20:1, Romans 8:31-39, fn 8:35-39, fn 8:38, Ephesians 6:10-12, fn 6:12) If Satan is ruler of this world (John 14:30), how will you be able to share your faith?

ARE SET APART—SANCTIFIED. As Jesus sanctified Himself and His work of crucifixion on the cross (John 18:11), He now sanctifies the disciples (and us!) and sends us into the world to do His work. (John 17:16-19, John 17:17, fn 17:17, John 20:21, fn 20:21, Matthew 28:18, 19, II Corinthians 5:18-20, fn 5:20, II Thessalonians 2:13-17, fn 2:14) God sent Jesus and the disciples into the world. What evidence in your life assures you that God has sent you into the world?

Check up—Are you praying with your spouse and your family? Group—Pray for personal requests and bond together by fellowshipping together.
