ACTS 1:6-8

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

THAT YOU WON'T KNOW EVERYTHING—Only God the Father knows when Jesus will return. In the interim, we have another kingdom to proclaim. (Acts 1:6, 7, fn 1:6, fn 1:6, 7, I Thessalonians 5:1-11, fn 5:1-3, fn 5:2, Luke 17:20, 21, fn 17:20, 21, I John 3:1-3, fn 3:2, 3) *How does not knowing when Christ will return help you in your relationship with Him?*

THAT YOU WILL RECEIVE POWER “The Greek word for power is ‘dynamis’ or explosive. The life-changing dynamic of the Holy Spirit is explosive.” James M. Boice, Acts, page 25. (Acts 1:8, fn 1:8 [1st], Acts 2:1-11, fn 2:4-11, Galatians 5:22-26, fn 5:22, 23) *How has the Holy Spirit’s power affected your thought life?*

THAT YOU WILL BE MY WITNESS—Our word for a witness comes from an old English word, “wit.” This word meant “to know.” A “wit” is a knowledgeable person. A witness is someone who knows something and testifies to it. James M. Boice, Acts, pages 26 and 27. (Acts 1:8, fn 1:8[2nd], fn 1:8[3rd], I Peter 3:14, 15, fn 3:15) *What qualifies you to be a witness for Christ?*
