

THE EVANGELISTIC JESUS

JOHN 4:1-26

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

BACKGROUND: Please read footnote John 4:4.

CROSSES SOCIAL BARRIERS. Jesus, the Creator of all mankind, so loved the world that he created that He was not willing for any walls of evil discrimination to prevent Him from saving His loved ones. (**John 4:1-9, fn 4:7-9, Galatians 3:26-29, fn 3:28, John 10:14-18, fn 10:16**) *What social barriers do you face in sharing the gospel and how could you overcome them?*

GIVES OPPORTUNITY TO RECEIVE HIM. Knowing facts such as the location of Jacob's well or having spiritual heritage or church attendance will not save anyone. There is no discrimination in salvation. Everyone who receives Christ comes the same way. We are saved by God's grace and the gift of faith in Jesus. (**John 4:10-17, fn 4:10, fn 4:13-15, John 1:12, 13, fn 1:12, 13, Ephesians 2:4-9, fn 2:8, 9, II Corinthians 6:2, fn 6:2**) *Why does God save everyone the same way and what is the urgency?*

SEEKS AND SAVES. No place or building is necessary for God to seek and save. God is spirit and He is omnipresent (everywhere). He seeks you to save you wherever you are because of His love for you. God saves you to have a relationship with Him and worship Him. When we humble ourselves and worship Him, He fills us with awe and devotion, and we become increasingly more like the One we are worshipping. (**John 4:18-26, fn 4:24, John 3:5-8, fn 3:8, John 14:25-27, fn 14:26, II Corinthians 5:17, fn 5:17**) *How and when could you worship Jesus during your week?*
