USING THE FOUR SPIRITUAL LAWS

I PETER 3:15d

BACKGROUND: All Christians have a starting point of faith. It is not simply going into a church building that makes you a believer. All Christians have the Holy Spirit and a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. (**John 14:6, Acts 4:12, Romans 8:14**) Please remember to take your copy of *The Four Spiritual Laws* to this meeting!

IT'S EASY TO INTRODUCE. The Bible says that God has placed eternity into each person's heart. There is a sense of lostness, or a deep sense of "There must be more to my life than I am experiencing." Their conscience in some way reminds them that that they have sinned. This is the time that the Lord makes a divine appointment for you to share the love of Jesus with them. Therefore, "Have you heard of The Four Spiritual Laws" is a great introduction. (I Peter 3:15, fn 3:15[2nd], Ecclesiastes 3:11, fn 3:11, I Timothy 2:1-5, fn 2:4, II Corinthians 5:16-21, fn 5:18-19) How could you be ready for a divine appointment?

IT'S EASY TO LEAD. Confidently read the pamphlet word by word with a pencil in hand, knowing the results rest with our Lord. "The Four Spiritual Laws" are so written that you do not have to stop for explanation. (I Peter 3:15, II Peter 3:8-9, fn 3:8-9, Proverbs 11:30, fn 11:30, John 4:34-38, fn 4:36-38, Romans 3:23, fn 3:23, Romans 3:27-28, fn 3:28) Set a goal! Make a list of five people with whom you could share "The Four Spiritual Laws".

IT'S EASY TO UNDERSTAND. With God's love and guidance from the Holy Spirit, you can lead someone to receive eternal life. When you lead someone to Christ in this way, you are also declaring to them that this experience of knowing Jesus is also your story. (I Peter 3:15, John 1:12-13, fn 1:12-13, John 3:16, fn 3:16[1st], Ephesians 2:8-9, fn 2:8-9, John 5:24, fn 5:24, I John 5:11-13, fn 5:13) Pair off in your group and practice reading "The Four Spiritual Laws" to one another.

Are you taking time to experience the presence of the Holy Spirit with the Living Word teaching you and giving you His joy, His love, and His peace?
