

FROM MY SLAVERY TO MY ADOPTION

ACTS 16:16-19

BACKGROUND: As you examine God's Word, please note that in God's eyes there is no difference in sons and daughters, and they are one in Christ Jesus. (**Galatians 3:28**) Remember to look in a mirror each day and repeat what you must know: "I am loved. I am beautiful. I am precious."

I NOW BY FAITH HAVE A NEW FAMILY WITH A NEW START. When Jesus came into my life, the old evil spirit that twisted God's Word had to leave. God's truth and Satan's lies do not mix. (**Acts 16:16-19, John 1:9-13, John 5:24, John 10:10, I John 3:1-3, Galatians 3:26**) *How could you become a child of God?*

I NOW BY FAITH HAVE A NEW FAMILY WITH A NEW FATHER. Jesus is my heavenly Father and I am His child. Jesus paid with His life to get me out of slavery so He could adopt me and give to me all the rights of those who belong to His family. (**Acts 16:16-19, Galatians 4:1-7, Ephesians 1:4-5, Romans 8:14-17, I Corinthians 6:18-20, I Corinthians 7:21-23**) *If you have the Holy Spirit, what does He tell you?*

I NOW BY FAITH HAVE A NEW FAMILY WITH A NEW LIFE. My new Father loves me and desires for me to have what he has. As proof to me of my adoption into His family, Jesus gave me the Holy Spirit. His presence will fill me with joy each day as I turn my life to receive what He has. (**John 14:15-21, Romans 5:1-5, I Corinthians 2:10-16, Galatians 5:22-23, I John 4:13-16**) *How could you have each day what Jesus has?*
